UNESCO Chair on Education, Citizenship and Cultural Diversity (ID 1278)

**Summary**

The UNESCO Chair in "Education, Citizenship and Cultural Diversity" at Lusófona University, create in 2018, has been developing a series of projects to strengthen the university's academic and educational actions. The Chair – from an academic, training and knowledge reciprocity perspective – is a space that facilitates and promotes dialogue and interaction between researchers, professionals, students, associations and civil society. The projects and activities developed through the Chair are based on a dialogic, plural and democratic perspective, allowing the reinforcement and enlargement of its vocation (cultural diversity and democratization, citizenship, socio-cultural inclusion, lifelong and education for all). The proposed activities are encouraging a diversity of scholars and students in the development of projects, specially noticed by 6 postgraduate study groups enhancing weekly discussions in collaboration with the Department of Museology. Debates and Seminars have been encouraging updated discussions and improving the impacts of the Chair – locally, nationally, and internationally. The activities carried out by the Chair have been bringing together researchers and students from various universities, raising the internationalization of the University and highlighting the importance of the proposed discussions. Over its 4 years of operation, the Chair has expanded and consolidated thematic networks that have fortified our commitments to UNESCO's mission and objectives, as well as our contribution to the SDGs.

**Renewal - Summary**

The development of the Chair's activities has always been subject to an integrated view of its different areas of activity. To this end, a close dialogue was maintained between people, organizations and the Academy. We work in the field of training (Graduate and Undergraduate); in the production of publications that could contribute to the deepening of content and critical reflection; in the organization of scientific events; and in the organization and maintenance of postgraduate study groups; always aiming at a close relationship with the fundamental objectives of the Chair.

Our six postgraduate study groups (composed by PhD and Master students, professionals and researchers integrated and external to the ULHT), broaden the commitment and guide the themes adopted by the Chair towards an even closer relationship between the Academy and social organizations.

These study groups highlighted the wealth of work and reflection that it is possible to build in the South-South and South-South-North relationship, through the adoption of decolonial thought and practice. It was therefore possible to broaden our relations with historically subordinated, racialized and genderized groups and people (acting, dialoguing with peoples from various regions of South America, Afro-descendants and Roma people).

The Chair's themes were integrated in the Graduate and Undergraduate Programs primarily by using possible approaches in Sociomuseology and Education. In this sense, the Chair was associated in the publication of the "Cadernos de Sociomuseologia" journal, giving rise to the publication of several volumes dedicated to Museology and Cultural Diversity, Education for citizen participation, Heritage and social memory, bodies and dissidence.

We developed Open Educational Resources (OER), available on the Sociomuseology Youtube channel, and edited 3 volumes of a new book collection to make available texts that contribute to an introduction to Sociomuseology. These texts establish the relationships between museological theory and practice in contemporary times and, in a more oriented way, propose a re-reading of Museology with a social matrix based on the reference work of Educator Paulo Freire.

We organized the "Paulo Freire Congress: A centenary of the present", in December 2021, which received more than 900 participants (from Europe, Asia, Africa and the Americas), bringing together professionals from different areas of knowledge.

Through the submission of Research Projects, it was possible to involve a growing number of social organizations, which work in the field of affirmative policies focused on issues of gender equality, social recognition of Afro-descendant and Roma Portuguese citizens, understood within the scope of intersectionality and the broadening the notions of citizenship and cultural diversity.

This horizontal methodology of work, based on training, research and university extension, committed to public debate and critical reflection, were permanently articulated with the work of study groups involving students, professionals and researchers, whose most visible expression is for holding more than 80 public seminars and webinars.

In fact, the Chair took advantage of the generalization of online communication using all the means made available by Lusófona University to maintain and expand the number of people, universities, institutions and community organizations involved (especially from Africa and Latin America).
